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## NurturePA Named *Champion in Action* by Citizens and Trib Total Media Expanding Mental Health and Well-Being Resources in Pittsburgh

This flexible approach allows for convenient and accessible support, ensuring that mothers can engage with their mentors at their own pace, whenever it suits them. Their program emphasizes the importance of maternal mental health and its direct impact on the social-emotional development of children. Together, they are building a community where moms feel supported, informed, and connected, fostering resilience and nurturing the next generation. Funding from the Champions in Action award will allow the organization to provide more than 130 moms with mentorship for one year and will enable the organization to expand their reach.
